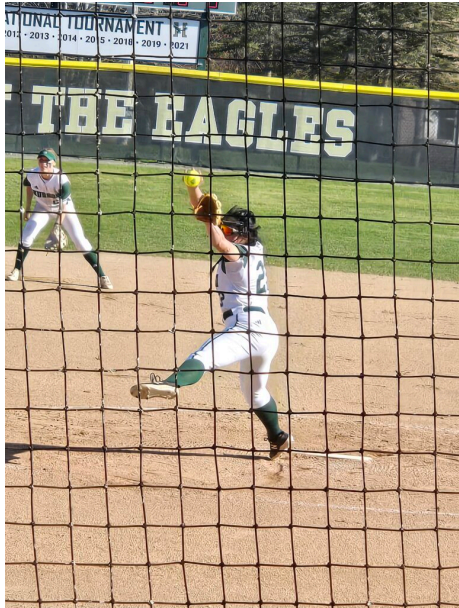


Maine baseball drops final regular season conference game to Binghamton
