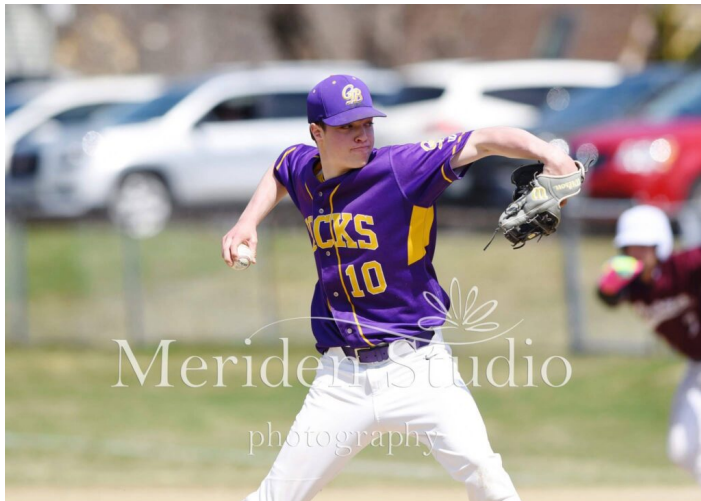
## **Mt. Ararat baseball knocks off Brewer**

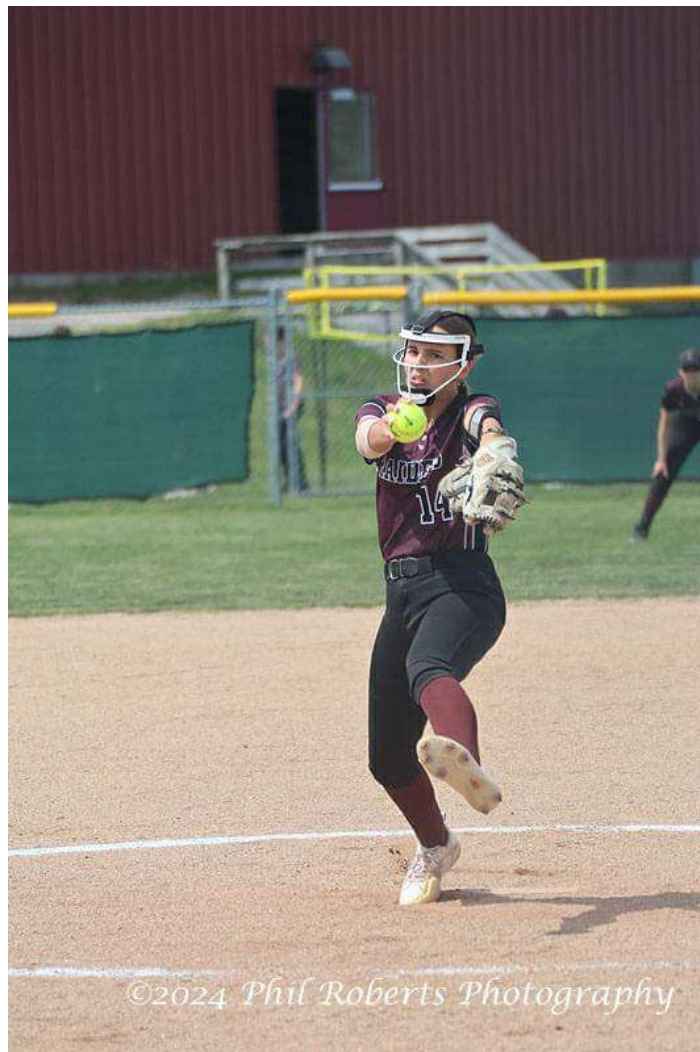

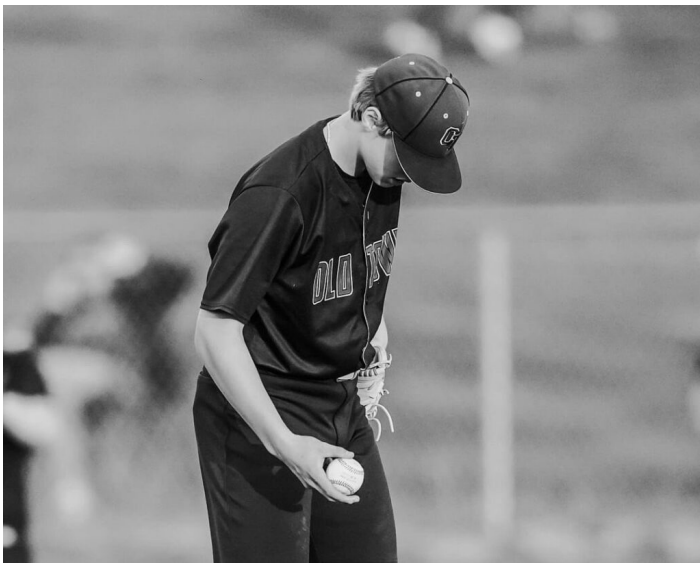
## Machias baseball rallies past Woodland
